

H2H Network Tigray Support Package II

Keep strengthening the humanitarian response in Ethiopia and in border areas of Sudan

In late 2020, the H2H Network activated its fund to scope needs; within a month, a package of technical services was developed supporting multilateral processes in Ethiopia and border areas of Sudan. Nearly seven months into the conflict, assessments clearly show that the humanitarian situation remains serious in the region and conclusions of the H2H Network's first activation confirm a strong need to keep strengthening the response. In May 2021, the H2H Network activated its fund to further support the humanitarian system with technical services, products, and tools in Ethiopia and in border areas of Sudan.
