## Nagorno-Karabakh service package

### **Needs assessment support to inform the humanitarian response in Nagorno-Karabakh.**

The H2H Network has activated its fund in response to a growing humanitarian emergency in the region of Nagorno-Karabakh. Two member agencies who specialize in assessments (Impact Initiatives/ REACH and ACAPS) will focus on collecting information on the needs of displaced people, aiming to inform and strengthen the wider humanitarian response. Projects start on 1 November and close on 31 December 2020.

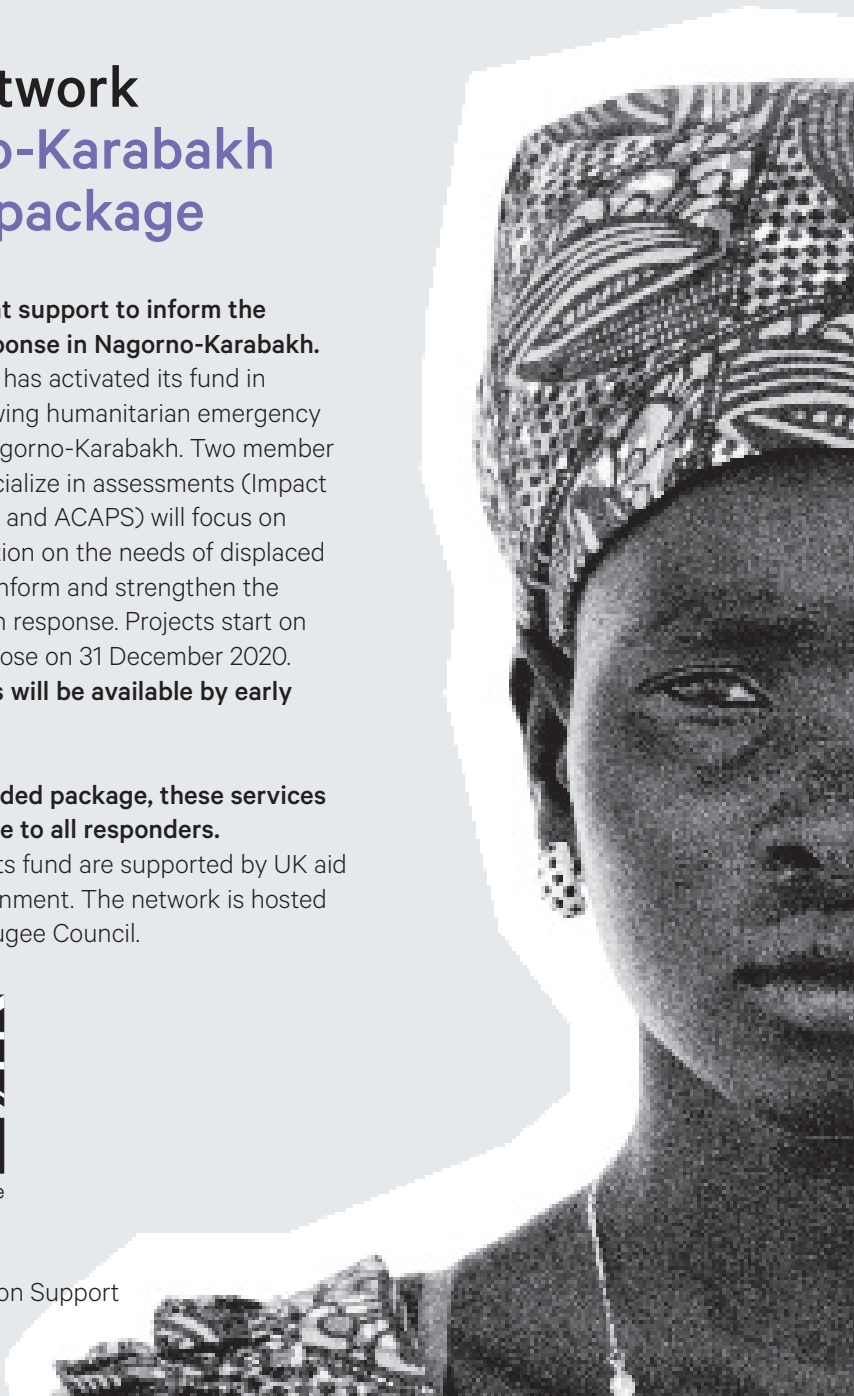
**First assessments will be available by early December.**
