### H2H technical services strengthen the humanitarian response with short-term technical support in the oPt recovery period

The escalation of hostilities between Israeli and Palestinian armed groups in Gaza between 10-21 May 2021 continues to generate serious humanitarian needs in the West Bank, Gaza, and East Jerusalem. The H2H Network has activated its fund to provide rapid funding for specialized member agencies to strengthen the humanitarian response with short-term technical support in the oPt recovery period.
